Booking Procedures & Rules

1. Any group over 20 players will be considered tournament size and will require a deposit to book tee times.
2. Shotgun starts on weekends will only be available for 9am start times and only for groups of 100 players or more, any less will be required to do regular tee times off first hole. Groups booking weekend play will be required to submit player numbers 7 days in advance and 100 will be the minimum for shotgun, if at that time their numbers are lower, they will be required to do tee times off the first tee or pay for the full 100 minimum.
3. A deposit of **\$500.00** is required to book any tournament under 72 golfers and **\$1000.00** for any tournament over 72 golfers to secure the date you would like. If cancelled a minimum of 14 days prior to the tournament, the deposit will be refunded. If cancellation is made less than 14 days from the booked date, deposit will not be refunded
4. All fees must be paid in full, **48 hours** prior to the tournament date. Payment on day of tournament is ok if approved by club management prior to tournament. Failure to submit the balance by the indicated date will result in the loss of the deposit and tournament date. There will be no exceptions.
5. The club is provide tee times, food, carts, staff, etc for a guaranteed number of players. No refund will be given for fewer participants than the number agreed upon **48hrs** prior to tournament.
6. A list of players needs be submitted to the tournament manager **48 hours** prior to date of play. All players are expected to tee off on time and **complete play in the time specified** by the club. (**9 holes, 2 1/2 hrs. and 18 holes, 5 hrs.**)
7. Power carts may be reserved in advance and paid in full at the same time as the tournament fees. Carts must be operated in a safe and courteous manner. Carts are the responsibility of the tournament any damage will be charged to the tournament we will provide the name of the individual assigned to that cart it will then be the tournaments responsibility to get payment from that individual.
8. Tournaments are liable for any damage done to carts by any players in their tournament. Security in the form of a credit card imprint will be required from all tournaments.
9. We have 50 carts available. If tournaments require additional carts, each extra cart will have a surcharge of \$70.00 to cover cost to bring to course (Min 12)



TOURNAMENT INFORMATION, RULES & DEFINITIONS

DRESS CODE

Proper golf attire must be worn at all times. The following are not permitted on the golf course:

- Undershirts/tank tops/muscle shirts and spaghetti straps
- Overalls
- Cutoffs
- Sweat suits

Only proper footwear (*i.e. golf footwear and soft-soled shoes*) will be allowed on the golf course. We are a soft-spike facility.

SPEED OF PLAY

All tournaments are required to play in a reasonable time frame. Speed of play is expected to be approximately 9 holes 2-1/2 hours and 18 holes at 5 hours.

Speed of Play Tips

- Always keep up with the group ahead.
- Mark the score at the next tee box.
- Move all clubs and carts toward the next tee before putting out.
- 2 minute maximum for finding lost balls.
- Read the tips occasionally during play.
- Everyone plays as slow as the slowest player—***Don't be the slowest player.***

COURSE ETIQUETTE

- Keep all carts at least 30 feet away from greens and tees.
- Golf carts stay on the cart path whenever applicable.
- Replace divots and repair ball marks on the greens.
- Deposit all garbage in the proper containers. Do not litter.

Green Fees: designated number of players a tournament has

Power Carts: Club Car Carts with roofs (up to 47) available, any requirements above this number will have a fleet rate of \$75.00 per cart (min 12 carts)

Rentals: we offer a 7 or 12-piece set

Continental Breakfast: optional meal available for any tournament before round

Banquet Dinner: your choice of menu item to satisfy all participants in your tournament

Pro shop Gift cards: monetary credit in the pro shop that is an available option

Directions from North (Edmonton, Ponoka)

Take Exit 431 off QEII continue following off ramp to the right onto township road 41-2 proceed 6km on twn 41-2 to intersection of twn 41-2 and RR 27-0 Turn Left onto RR 27-0 proceed 1.6km to entrance of Course

From South (Red Deer, Calgary)

Take Exit 431 off QEII continue following off ramp to the right to stop sign. Turn Left onto Hwy 2a take Overpass over QEII proceed strait onto township road 41-2 proceed 6km on twn 41-2 to intersection of twn 41-2 and RR 27-0, turn Left onto RR 27-0 proceed 1.6km to entrance of Course

From East (Clive, Tees, Stettler)

Take Hwy 12 to intersection of Hwy 2a turn tight onto Hwy 2a proceed though town to Overpass over QEII proceed strait onto township road 41-2 proceed 6km on twn 41-2 to intersection of twn 41-2 and RR 27-0, turn Left onto RR 27-0 proceed 1.6km to entrance of Course

From West (Gull Lake, Bentley, Rimbey)

Many Different way depending were they are; easiest for most will be to take Hwy 12 to QEII then follow "From South" directions
