Mens Night Information

Welcome to Mens Night 2025! This year teams must register with club house staff prior to or during your first time attending mens night. This will provide us with the ability to update all mens night participants.

Our mens night is a two person team format. You can come with an established pair or come alone and find another single to pair up with for the season!

The earlier you start the more points you can collect!

Format

The standard format will be 2 vs. 2 best ball scramble match play.

Best Ball:

All players will tee off. Each pair will choose their best shot and shoot their second shot from the "best ball". Each team will do this till they finish the hole.

Match Play:

Each team of two will keep track of their score on each hole. If team A shot a 6, and team B shot a 4, team B would win that hole and would go 1 up. The end score of each hole does not matter, just the over all winner of each hole.

The team that won the most holes wins the round.

Point System

Win: 3 points

Tie: 2 points

Loss: 1 point

Modified Deuce Pot

- Players can place as many toonies as they would like in the "deuce pot" on the counter near the check in desk. Once you have put a toonie in the pot you must write your name and put it in the bucket beside the "deuce pot". You only need to put your name in once. This helps us track who has and hasn't contributed to the pot. You can add as many toonies as you would like to help increase the pots value. You are putting in for your TEAM
- At the end of the night we will pull a card. Whichever card is pulled is the hole that you need to have gotten a birdie on to win the pot. If no one gets a birdie on the hole chosen, a name draw will occur. If two or more teams get a birdie, we will draw between those teams for the pot.

You can only win the pot if you contribute to the pot!
